RE: 2022 Senior School Recommended Stationery List

In the Kimberley College senior school (Years 10 to 12), the College provides text books, online interactive portals (in subjects where they are available) and printed resources for students over the course of the three years of study. Our school has computer labs for specific subjects with high level requirements, however, like many other high schools we are a 'Bring Your Own Device' (BYOD) school with regard to computer requirements. **All senior school students require a laptop with word processing and spread-sheeting software as well as internet access for all senior subjects.**

The attached recommended stationery list provides a general outline of items that your child/ren will require to commence the school year. The most successful students of the past have separate folders for each of their senior subjects and only bring the subjects they have each day to school.

Specific school subjects such as Visual Art will specify some additional items to their classes at the start of the year. Students in Mathematical Methods & Specialist Mathematics will also require a graphics calculator later in the year that will cost approximately \$250. This calculator will be useful for these students beyond their secondary schooling at university as well. Families will be sent a letter specifying which device to buy later in the year so that this cost is delayed until necessary. To begin with in these maths subjects, the Casio fx82AUplusII specified in the General Stationery list will meet the initial requirements of the course and provides a good introduction to the Casio format. Please buy the Casio specified for your child's benefit.

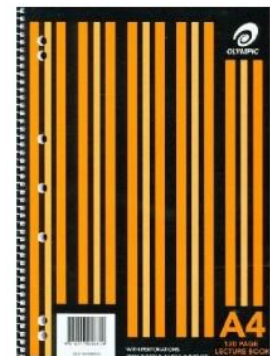
The items specified in our list were available from School Locker previously at competitive prices. You may of course purchase equivalent items from other retailers if you wish. We ask that you do not vary from the recommended calculator though, as it has advanced screen function and examples in the textbooks we use, model using this calculator. Also, the Marbig/Studymate ruler with cm & mm is strongly recommended; other rulers have cm & inches. Imperial measurements such as inches are never used in our senior school subjects and millimetres are an advantage when graphing, in particular when dealing with percentages or when working with maps and scale diagrams.
